1. Beside above, other shortlisting criteria remain as per Institute requirement.
2. Currently registered students in Centrally Funded Technical Institutes (CETIs) having CGPA of 8.0 or above (on a 10 point scale) at the end of 6<sup>th</sup> semester or later, in B. Tech/BE/Integrated M.Tech/ Integrated M. Sc. programmes (or any other programme of minimum four year duration, admission to which is on the basis of JEE), the requirement of GATE/National Exam is waived for consideration of admission to the M.S. (R) programme in IIT Delhi. Moreover, such students must have obtain a CGPA of 8.0 or above at the time of graduation (and before they formally register for the M.S. (R) programme.)
3. Graduates of CFTIs (in the programmes marked under (i) with a final graduation CGPA of more than 8.0 (80% aggregate marks, if marks is the primary mode of evaluation.)
4. Interview of all shortlisted applicants will be held on 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> December 2019.
