**Shortlisting Criteria for Interview Calls for Ist Semester 2017-2018 admissions to M.Tech.
(Full-Time) Programs & M.S. (Research) (Full-Time) Program.**

- I. For General/OBC category, minimum 60% marks or CGPA of 6.75 is required on a scale of 10 in qualifying degree.
- II. For SC/ST/PH category, minimum 55% marks or CGPA of 6.25 is required on a scale of 10 in qualifying degree.

- III. Minimum GATE Score is required as per Table below.
