Due to incorrect/missing information in your application or any other reason, you might not have been shortlisted and accordingly no interview call letter would have been sent to you. However, if you are sure that you fulfil the Ph.D. shortlisting criteria given in Appendices I & II, you may report for the interview on 22nd May 2018 with complete details for reconsideration for the interview. The details include *marksheets/grade cards, degree certificates, caste certificate if applicable and No-Objection Certificate/Sponsorship Certificate of current date from your employer along with experience certificates, where applicable.*

Please note that your claim for reimbursement of travel expenses (as given in the information brochure) will be entertained only if you fulfil the shortlisting criteria for Ph.D. program and appear for interview.

\$ Applicants with B.Tech. degree from any IIT with minimum CGPA of 8.0 are exempted from GATE Score.

Appendix-II

CGPA in IIT system means cumulative points secured in courses with pass grades by you in all semesters of your qualifying degree divided by cumulative earned credits (excluding audit and non-graded courses, such as NCC, NSO, NSS, Club activities, etc. whose credits or marks are not counted in the final result) in all semesters. Points secured in any course is obtained by multiplying the earned credits in that course with the grade points obtained in that course. However, if you are in the final semester and awaiting degree, you may calculate CGPA obtained by you till the previous semester. For greater details to calculate CGPA, please refer to Para 2.9 (from Page no. 8 to 12) in the [Courses of Study 2017-2018](#).

Percentage marks is the percentage of total cumulative marks received by you out of the total cumulative maximum marks in all semesters (or up to previous semester if you are in the final semester and awaiting degree).
