Appendix-II

CGPA in IIT system means cumulative points secured in courses with pass grades by you in all semesters of your qualifying degree divided by cumulative earned credits (excluding audit and non-graded courses, such as NCC, NSO, NSS, Club activities, etc. whose credits or marks are not counted in the final result) in all semesters. Points secured in any course is obtained by multiplying the earned credits in that course with the grade points obtained in that course. However, if you are in the final semester and awaiting degree, you may calculate CGPA obtained by you till the previous semester. For greater details to calculate CGPA, please refer to Para 2.9 (from Page no. 8 to 12) in the [Courses of Study 2017-2018](#).

Percentage marks is the percentage of total cumulative marks received by you out of the total cumulative maximum marks in all semesters (or up to previous semester if you are in the final semester and awaiting degree).
