- Besides the above, other shortlisting criteria remain as per Institute criteria.
- Applicants in the final year of B.Tech./B.E. are also eligible and will be shortlisted as per the table above based on their CGPA up to the end of seventh semester or third year (in case of yearly pattern).
- The Civil Engineering Department will offer direct admission to all GATE qualified applicants through [COAP 2025](#) portal. The Department will not conduct any interview or written test for the GATE qualified applicants. For direct admission, separate merit lists for each program will be prepared solely based on valid maximum GATE scores.
- For graduates of an IITs belonging to any category, GATE Score is NOT required but a minimum CGPA of 8.0 is required on a scale of 10 in their B.Tech. degree. If IIT applicants also fulfil the criteria as GATE qualified applicants, their names will also appear in the merit lists prepared for GATE qualified applicants.
- Some M.Tech. programs also earmark a few seats for applicants from other disciplines (holding degrees other than Civil Engineering). The shortlisting of these applicants will be based solely on the GATE score obtained by them in their discipline. Applicants with a degree in Civil Engineering but GATE qualified in other disciplines will be considered for only these earmarked seats.
