1. Besides above, other shortlisting criteria remain as per Institute criteria.
2. Applicants in the final year of B.Tech./B.E. are also eligible and will be shortlisted as per the table above based on their CGPA up to the end of seventh semester or third year (in case of yearly pattern).
3. Civil Engineering Department will offer direct admission to all GATE qualified applicants through COAP. The Department will not conduct any interview for the GATE qualified applicants. For direct admission, merit list will be prepared solely based on maximum GATE score obtained in any one of the present year or previous two years, i.e., in the years 2022, 2021 or 2020.
4. For graduates of an IIT belonging to any category, GATE score is NOT required but a minimum CGPA of 8.0 is required on a scale of 10 in B.Tech. degree. Interview of IIT applicants will be held for their first choice only. If IIT applicants also fulfil the criteria as GATE qualified applicants, their names will also appear in GATE merit list.
5. Some M.Tech. programs also earmark a few seats for applicants from other disciplines (holding degrees other than Civil Engineering). Shortlisting of these applicants will be based solely on the GATE score obtained by them in their discipline or in Environmental Sciences, as may be applicable.
